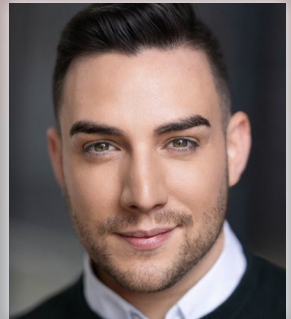

A Tallaght native, Kevin has been in the show business industry for many years having been one of the lucky ones to star in the 20th anniversary spotlight production of 'Bugsy Malone' in The Olympia Theatre at the age of 11. From there he continued his love for acting and played a principal role in many shows over the years before becoming a finalist on the voice of Ireland mentored by Sharon Corr of the Corrs. Kevin has worked alongside some of Ireland's most well-known talents

in the show business industry as well as having toured The States in 2019 as a backing vocalist for Celtic Woman. Kevin also plays the role of 'Wiggles' in The annual Civic Halloween Spooktacular. This year he is absolutely buzzing to return to his role for the **fifth** year as the firm family favourite character Tickles in this year's Civic Panto. Celebrating his very own 21st year in the showbiz industry.

Robert Downes - Dame Dottie

Robert is a Dublin based actor, writer, creative producer, director and drama facilitator. He is a graduate of TU Dublin's BA Drama Performance course and NUI Galway's MA in Drama Studies. He is also artistic director of SQUAD Productions Dublin- a theatre company that creates original and socially engaged theatre experiences for Irish audiences. Robert works for Smock Alley Theatre as a Creative Producer and Cultural Engagement liaison with a focus on community arts and new writing for the professional stage. He has always loved panto and is and is only delirious to be back at the Civic for 'Tickles, Beauty and the Beast!'.



Adam O'Shea - Gaston

Adam Michael O'Shea is an Irish actor from Waterford with a strong background in musical theatre. He graduated from London Studio Centre, where he received the Sheila O'Neill Award for most outstanding all-around student. Past recipients of this award include actor Luke Evans and Elizabeth Hurley. Adam's musical theatre credits include playing Mutt in the multi-award-winning 'Kinky Boots', where he worked with renowned Broadway director and choreographer Jerry Mitchell. Other roles include Max in 'Cabaret' and Mike in 'Oklahoma!'

For the past three years, Adam has been a member of The Celtic Harps, touring globally. He was also a contestant on 'The Voice UK 2024', where The Celtic Harps were recognized as the Best New International Group at the Celtic Music Awards. Adam has been focusing on his music career, including his debut charity Christmas single 'Christmas in Galway', which received national and global recognition including a HotPress magazine award as an upcoming artist to watch. Adam is delighted to be joining the cast of 'Tickles, Beauty and the Beast' as Gaston at The Civic theatre and can't wait to hear all your boos!

Ríona Keogh - Belle

Ríona is from Rathfarnham, Dublin and is so delighted to be playing Belle in the Civic Panto this year! Ríona holds a BA (Hons) Degree in Music & English and a MSc (Hons) from UCD and trained in Classical Voice at the T.U Conservatoire of Music & Drama. Whilst studying at UCD, she was an active member of UCD Musical Society, playing Hope Cladwell in 'Urinetown', Vocally Directing 'Gypsy' and Musically Directing/ Assistant Directing 'Rocketman' (Musical Theatre Intervarsities). Ríona is currently a member of HXT Musical Society and performed at The Civic as Wednesday Addams in 'The Addams Family Musical', November 2025. Theatre Credits include 'Star-To-Be in 'Annie' (Festival Productions, National Concert Hall), Bet in 'Oliver' (R&R Musical Society, National Concert Hall), Gingy/Wicked Witch in 'Shrek' (SGPA, Helix Theatre), Sharpay in 'High School Musical' (Encore!, Helix Theatre) and Ermengarde in 'Hello, Dolly!' (Pioneers M.D.S, Draíocht). Additionally, she was the Assistant Director for 'Les Miserables' at the Helix Theatre with SGPA. Ríona was delighted to perform as a soloist as part of the AIMS Opening Number 2024 (INEC Killarney) and has previously had the pleasure of singing with the RTÉ Concert Orchestra in the NCH. She has received a High Achiever Award from the Royal Irish Academy of Music and has been nominated for the Leinster School of Music and Drama Excellence Award. Ríona is represented by Maureen V Ward Talent Agency. Ríona is delighted to perform in her first panto as Belle in 'Tickles, Beauty and the Beast', alongside an extremely talented cast, production team and crew.



Tim Landers - Boris

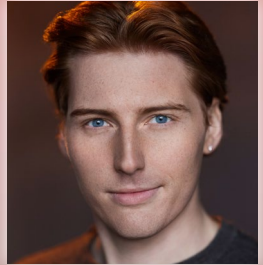


A Tralee based Dublin native, Tim is absolutely thrilled to be making his Civic panto debut this year in the role of Belle's Dad. He is no stranger to panto having appeared in other Irish and UK pantos such as 'Sinbad' at The Playhouse, Essex and 'Aladdin' at Siamsa Tire Theatre, Tralee, both times as the Baddie and as one of the Ugly Sisters in his own self written version of 'Cinderella' at Siamsa, where he had a ball as Whitney Heuston Station!!!. He also appeared as the Man in the Big Red Coat in the SFX panto 'Santas Xmas Mystery' some years ago where the music was written by Eurovision legend Shay Healy.

He has been performing in musicals for over 35 years since his musical debut in 'Seven Brides for Seven Brothers' in Galway in 1990. His favourite musical theatre roles include Judas, Pilate and Herod in 'Jesus Christ Superstar', Emcee in 'Cabaret', Father in 'Children of Eden', Jud Fry in 'Oklahoma', Judge Turpin in 'Sweeney Todd', Baron Bomburst in 'Chitty Chitty Bang Bang' to name but a few. In June 2014 Tim won the Best Comedian award in the Association of Irish Musical Theatre awards for the role of the mad German playwright Franz Leibkind in 'The Producers'. He has also directed many musicals and he won Best Director for his production of 'Guys and Dolls' at the Waterford Light Opera Festival. He was also a member of the ensemble cast of the Gate Theatre's 2005 production 'A View from The Bridge', directed by Mark Brokaw, which was nominated for Best Irish Production in The Irish Times Theatre Awards. In September 2023 Tim was cast as the main narrator/vocalist in UK production company Seven Productions touring stage show 'Seven Drunken Nights The Story of the Dubliners', making his West End debut at the Dominion Theatre, London in March 2024 and since then he has done three tours touring Europe, the UK and Ireland. Last winter he toured the UK and Ireland in the company's other show 'Fairytale of New York' and he has now performed in over 150 shows for that company. He would like to wish the cast and crew the very best and hope you enjoy the show.

Austin Prebula - The Prince/Beast

Austin Prebula is excited to join the Civic Theatre's cast of Tickle, Beauty and the Beast for his first Panto. Austin is a graduate of the Manhattan School of Music's inaugural musical theatre program, and has performed internationally with the Walt Disney Entertainment Company; having most recently performed in Beauty and the Beast Live in Hollywood studios and previously created magic at sea as a Main Stage performer aboard the Disney Wish on Disney Cruise-lines. Austin is passionate about classical theatre and acting, and has trained in Shakespeare at LAMDA and also takes classes at the Lir Academy in order to further enrich his craft.

At Sallynoggin college of further education, Sarah completed her fulltime training in dance. After that, she continued her education at the London College of Music and earned a diploma in Musical Theatre Performance. During this time she was extended an invitation to train at the North London Dance Studios on a full scholarship whilst attending Westside Stage School. In addition to that she took vocal lessons via the ABRSM under the tuition of Karen Blanzky. Professional credits include, 'Whiskey In The Jar the Musical' (Irish Premiere), 'The Promise' (Irish Premiere, Helix Theatre), Lead vocalist in Wilde nights on the board The Oscar Wilde for Irish Ferries. In 2015 Sarah performed as leading vocalist for one of the most prestigious cruise lines on The Seabourn Quest completing a world cruise visiting over 20 countries. Sarah was cast as a featured dancer in the box office smash hit movie 'Mrs Browns Boys D' Movie'. She was lead vocalist and dancer in Rob Murphys 'Let Loose' which played Vicar Street Dublin. In 2022 Sarah played Fairy Lolly in the civic panto 'Sleeping Beauty'. In 2023 she returned to The Civic as the evil stepmother Malaria in 'Cinderella'. She played the evil Baroness Trump last year in the Civic theatres sell out production of 'Tickle and the Beanstalk'. Sarah also performed in her first sell out solo show as part of Musical Mondays here in the Civic last year. In addition to that Sarah has been working as a teacher of performing arts to children and adults in a variety of stage and theatre schools across Ireland since 2005.

Meet The Crew

Rob Murphy - Producer, Writer & Director

Rob has recently graduated from University College Dublin with a First Class Honours Master's Degree in Theatre Practice. Bull Alley Theatre Training Company and Trinity Guildhall London were among his former institutions of training. Rob has been working professionally for the past fifteen years and his work encompasses acting, performing, theatre directing, choreographing, producing, and writing. He is well renowned for his performance as panto dame "Buffy" in the yearly pantomime production at Dublin's National Stadium (previously The Tivoli Theatre) - 'Queen Of The Panto Dames' (*The Irish Times*).



Other career highlights include premiering the one man show '69 Shades Of Gay' for Zac Productions at Smock Alley Theatre, playing the Wicked Witch in 'The Wizard Of Oz' at the Helix, playing The Olympia Panto Dame in 'Jack and The Beanstalk' 2006 for Spotlight Productions and his own comedy cabaret show 'Rob Murphy Let Loose' recently sold out at Dublin's legendary Vicar St. He is also a weekly contributor on Dublins Q102 breakfast show.

For the last 10 years, he has directed The Civic Theatre Summer Camp. Since 2018, he has also directed and produced, in partnership with The Civic, the annual professional pantomime production which has been highly successful, entertaining over 16,000 patrons a year. Rob has been an associate artist with the Civic for the last four years. He is also the artistic director of Dramatic Action Stage School with classes in Dublin, Kildare and Kilkenny and in 2018 won 'Best School Director' at the All Ireland Dance Awards. The school runs classes five days a week and each season culminates in annual showcases.

He recently wrote and directed 'Mary Byrne Check Me Out', a new one woman show starring X Factor sensation Mary Byrne. The show received rave reviews and toured the country during Summer 2024, finishing in Dublin's Olympia Theatre. He also wrote and directed 'Safety In Sequins', a brand new musical which was featured in the Scene & Heard Festival 2024 and Smock Alley Theatre, Dublin.



Kyra Clifford - Stage Manager

Kyra is a graduate of the Bull Alley Theatre Training Company and holds an ATCL Diploma from Trinity Guildhall, London. She is a dedicated drama and singing instructor with Dramatic Action Stage School and also works extensively as a stage manager and workshop facilitator. Kyra is a long-standing drama tutor for the highly successful Civic Theatre Summer Camp. Her professional credits include serving as

Assistant Director for 'Rob Murphy Let Loose' (Vicar Street, 2022), Assistant Stage Manager for the Civic Panto 'Sleeping Beauty' (2022), and Stage Manager for 'Cinderella' (2023). Kyra also worked on Karl Broderick and Alan Hughes' 'Aladdin' (National Stadium, 2021) and toured Ireland with 'Mary Byrne: Check Me Out', an autobiographical stage production. She is delighted to be returning as Stage Manager for this year's Civic Theatre pantomime.

Alan has been the Director of Dizzy Footwork Productions Ltd. Dance Academy and Drama Academy alongside his sister Lisa McGrath for the past 17 years, based in Rua Red Arts Centre Tallaght, which makes this extra special for him, working so close to home this Christmas. His Film & TV Credits include Disney's 'Disenchanted' (Dance Captain), EMA's MTV Awards, Eurovision 2018, Eurovision 2013, ITV This Morning with Jedward, The Voice of Ireland, Ireland's Got Talent Season One & Two, 'Penny Dreadful', 'The Tudors', 'Vikings', 'Little Women', 'My Super Sweet 16' MTV, Ireland Am Guest Choreographer, RTÉ Junior Industry Expert Panel, 'Don't Tell The Bride' (Choreographer) and more.

His theatre credits include 'Singin' in the Rain' (Cork Opera House), 'Grease' & 'Tribute to Earl Gill' (Gaiety), 'Pirates of Penzance' & 'Sleeping Beauty' (Helix), 'The Nutcracker', 'Cinderella', 'Sleeping Beauty', 'Peter Pan', 'Beauty & The Beast', 'Aladdin' (Dance Captain & Assistant Choreographer), Late Late Toy Show and more. Music Video Choreography credits include 'Window Pain' starring Gemma Lee Deveraux, 'Gone' by James Vincent McMorrow and 'High & Low' by Gemma Hayes among others. Alan has also performed with artists as varied as Justin Bieber, David Guetta, Jessie J, Selena Gomez, Tao Cruz and Flo Rida at the Odyssey Arena, London Beat, Ace of Base at 3 Arena and was part of the support act for the Westlife Farewell Tour. He has also choreographed for Samantha Mumba and performed on the Eurovision Tour. He has choreographed for 'Hansel & Gretel' Ambassador Theatre, 'Little Red and The Big Bad Wolf' Civic Theatre, 'Tickles & The Beanstalk' Civic Theatre. Duffy's Circus 2025. Alan would like to say a huge thank you to everyone for welcoming him with open arms again this year and would like to wish all the cast and crew a very successful run.

Elaine Gallagher - Musical & Assistant Director

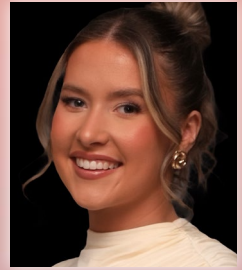
